

Diamonds Are a Girl's Best Friend

Supply List

The best use of your time during this workshop is to learn how to make diamond-shaped blocks and explore your options. You can make your real project after class. In a three hour class there is not time to focus on a project, just the process. The image at the right is the quilt from my book. It is a possible project for you to begin in class and complete after class.

Please bring all of the following to class.

Book, *Another Can of Worms*, by Debbie Caffrey. The book is **OPTIONAL**. Bring it if you have it. I will have books available for purchase during class.

Rotary cutter, mat, & rulers – Bring a long wide ruler for cutting strips and a 60° triangle tool. Any brand of 60° triangle should work, but to make sure you have size options, it should have a lot of markings on it. Some 60° triangles have no markings. They will still work, but will limit your design options. I will have Creative Grid 60° triangles available for purchase during class.

Thread to blend with your fabrics

Fabric

Option #1 – If you want to do some exercises to learn how to make different sizes and blocks, bring one yard each of three or four pieces that coordinate and have some value contrast.

Option #2 – If you plan to duplicate the quilt shown at the right, you will need the following fabrics.

Eighteen 2½" x 40" or Thirty-six 2½" x 20" strips, half of them light and half of them dark.

Sashing	1⅝ yards
Setting Triangles & Border	1½ yards
Binding	⅝ yard
Backing	2¾ yards



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
