

It's Hip to be Square

Supply List

In this workshop you will learn how to make a variety of blocks including Split Nine Patch, a simple Nine Patch Autumn Leaf, a scrappy Bear's Paw, Friendship Stars, Delectable Mountains, etc...by making very simple, large (usually 4½" - 10") half-square triangle units.

Please bring all of the following to class with you.

NOTE: Everyone must bring fabric option #1.

In addition, for a project bring fabric for option #2, #3, or #4.

- **Books** – The following *books are optional*. All three contain information that supports the workshop. You may purchase any of them via my website or during the workshop.

- **Sewing Machine**
- **Thread** to blend with your fabrics
- **Rotary Cutter, Mat, & Rulers** – Bring an 8½" or a 9½" square if you have one.
- **Fabric, option 1 – Everyone should bring the following:** Bring equal amounts of light and dark fabric to do some exercises to learn the techniques. Most of the blocks begin with squares that measure 8" - 8½". So, get into your stash and pull a small pile of fat quarters, quarter yard cuts, and/or scraps to use for these blocks. Have the equivalent of three or four fat quarters of each value for the exercises.
- **Fabric, option 2** – Plan to begin the *September Song* quilt, finished size is 60" square. See image on page 2. You will be provided the pattern in class.
The fabric requirements for the *September Song* quilt are as follows:

Fall colored fabrics	twelve fat quarters
Background fabric	2 yards
Main print fabric	2 yards
Sashing & narrow border	1½ yards
- **Fabric, option 3** – Plan to begin any quilt in the books *IT'S HIP TO BE SQUARE*, *DELECTABLY SIMPLE MOUNTAINS*, or the *Robo-Cats* quilt from *POWER CUTTING, TOO*
- **Fabric, option 4** – Plan to design your own project with the techniques you learn. Bring a dozen or more fat quarters of light and an equal number of fat quarters of dark to begin a design of your own. Bring sashing and border fabrics, too, if you think you will use them. Contact me if you need more advice on this option.
