Supply List

In class you will not only learn how to make the quilt shown on the pattern cover, but how to redraft and easily rotary cut other sizes, too. This knowledge will help you do the same with other blocks you make in the future.

The pattern will be provided in class.

Please bring all of the following to class with you:

- **Sewing Machine**
- **Thread** to blend with your fabrics.
- **Rotary Cutter, Mat, & Rulers** – a 12" x 18" mat is suggested. Bring a 6" x 12" or comparable size ruler. Bring an Omnigrid 96 or 96L half-square triangle tool. *I will have Omnigrid 96L's available for purchase during class.*
- **Judy Martin Point Trimmer tool, optional** – You can use a ruler, but the point trimmer is so convenient and simple to use. *I will have Point Trimmers available for purchase during class.*
- **Fabric**– Six dark strips for backgrounds of blocks, 4½" x 40"; ½ yard light star fabric; and ¼ yard of a second light fabric. This is enough fabric to make six 11" blocks. Coordinate them for a project if you like, but remember, I want to teach you to make different sizes, so bringing dark strips of just any fabric for the exercises is encouraged. Below is a complete list of fabric requirement to duplicate my quilt.

The finished size of the *Lightning Quick* quilt shown on page 2 is 56½" x 72".

To make the *Lightning Quick* quilt:

Fabric

Darks for Blocks' Backgrounds	18 different fabrics, one 4½" x 40" strip of each
Yellow Star	⅞ yard
Light	¼ yard or fat quarter
Border	2 yards
Binding	¾ yard
Backing	3½ yards

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
