

Scraps to You, Too **Workshop Supply List**

Please bring the following to class.

Book, if you have it – *Scraps to You, Too* by Debbie Caffrey – ***optional*** – Handouts will be provided for the basic instruction and exercise. Book is available for purchase through my website and during class.

Rotary Cutter & Mat – mat should be 12" x 18" or larger

Rulers & Tools – One ruler for strip cutting pieces up to 4⁷/₈" wide.

Omnigrd 96 or Omnigrd 96L triangle tool – If you do not own either of these triangle tools, purchase the larger one, the Omnigrd 96L. Tools are available for purchase through my web site and during class.

Thread to blend with your fabrics

Fabric

The first part of class will be spent doing exercises to

learn my strip-piecing technique,
learn other chain-piecing applications,
vary the size for other quilts,
examine various blocks to see where this technique can be used, and
consider using it as a design unit by itself.

Therefore, please bring several fat quarters or half yard pieces of fabric to class. These pieces are just for exercises, but could become part of a quilt. Coordinate them if you wish, or just grab something that you do not mind using up. Now is a great time to experiment with color! Select a variety of values and scales. Please, do not bring long yardage of fabric for this part of the workshop! You will spend too much of the class period wrestling with it.

Additionally, you may have a little time to begin a quilt by the middle of the class or work on more samples. A collection of fat quarters with good contrast is one place to begin. I will be happy to guide you as you design your own quilt.

A second option is to consult my book, *Scraps to You, Too*, for more ideas and the fabric requirements to make any of the quilts in the book. In a half day class, there is very little time to get into the larger quilts, but you will have the knowledge to make any of them by the end of class.
